貝里斯大學「區域語文中心」獎學金開放申請

115 年 5 月 19 日

貝里斯大學(University of Belize)「區域語文中心」(Regional Language Center, RLC)將於明(2027)年 1 月至 10 月開辦「Certificate of English as a Second Language」英語課程，並提供獎學金名額供我國人申請，除學雜費全免外，另補助每位受獎生每月 600 貝幣(折合約 300 美元)之生活費，為期 10 個月。

凡年滿 18 歲、具備我國國籍及高中(含)以上學歷者均可申請，有意者請備妥申請表、推薦信、簡歷、效期六個月以上之中華民國護照影本及翻譯成英文並經公證的學歷證明、成績單及出生證明等文件，於本(2026)年 7 月 31 日前郵寄至 admissions@ub.edu.bz 及 rlcinfo@ub.edu.bz，繳交報名費貝幣 30 元(美金 15 元)，提出申請。

此獎學金計畫除提供名額予台灣外，亦提供名額予墨西哥、宏都拉斯、薩爾瓦多、巴拿馬、哥倫比亞及委內瑞拉等國。該課程之學生多來自鄰近西語系國家，台灣受獎生除透過此課程精進其英語能力外，亦可藉此與來自西語系國家之同學互動交流。

貝里斯政府 2026-2027 年獎學金： 貝里斯大學英語作為第二外語學程

概述

貝里斯大學「英語課程獎學金計畫」概述

貝里斯大學(University of Belize, UB)與貝國「教育、文化、科學暨科技部」邀請有意者申請「2026-2027 英語課程獎學金計畫」。由貝里斯大學「區域語文中心」(Regional Language Center, RLC)從 2027 年 1 月到 10 月，提供為期 10 個月的密集英語課程。

此計畫是由貝里斯政府贊助的獎學金計劃，以支付學費、課程費用和所需的教材及每月貝里斯幣 600 元之生活津貼。

計畫宗旨

貝大區域語言中心英語作為第二外語學程

該學程係為強化學員的英語閱讀、寫作、聽力及口語等能力而設計，強調溝通能力、以技能導向學習及語言技巧之實際運用。合格學生須必修 60 小時的語言實習。

受獎生對象：

此獎學金計畫開放予中華民國(台灣)、墨西哥、宏都拉斯、薩爾瓦多、哥倫比亞、巴拿馬、委內瑞拉之國民申請。

申請資格：

- 申請者須為中華民國(台灣)、墨西哥、宏都拉斯、薩爾瓦多、哥倫比亞、巴拿馬、委內瑞拉之國民。
- 申請者申請時須年滿18歲。
- 申請者須承諾在2027年1月至2027年10月期間居住貝里斯。

- 申請人必須至少持有高中學歷。
- 須承諾在貝里斯全職學習，申請者不可兼職或兼修學程。

限制條件：

- 同一家庭或家戶最多僅受理一人申請，其配偶或同居人不得同時申請。
- 貝里斯公民之配偶、持有貝里斯護照、國籍或永久居留權者

獲選條件

- 填妥UB/RLC申請表格
- 提供所需文件。
- 具備英語基本至中階水準。
- 可全程參加10個月之課程。

申請所需文件

申請人須提交下列文件：

- 填妥UB/RLC申請表格（如附件）。
- 個人最新之履歷表並附照片（如非英文履歷，須譯成英文）。
- 經公證之學歷成績證明，如非英文應翻譯成英文。
- 經公證之學歷證書或文憑，如非英文應翻譯成英文。
- 1封推薦信，推薦人可為學術機構、前任或現任雇主。請使用貝大推薦信範本。
- 經公證之本人護照資料頁影本，效期至少6個月以上。
- 經公證或驗證之出生證明文件影本，如非英文應翻譯成英文。
- 報名費貝里斯幣30元 – 可以信用卡支付。

獎學金

- 貝里斯大學「英語課程獎學金計畫」將負擔所有的學雜費，包含教材，另提供生活津貼每月貝里斯幣600元（折合300美元）。
- 生活津貼用於補助房租及水電，超出生活津貼額度之支出由受獎生自行負擔。
- 獎學金只資助受獎生本人，不及於其眷屬。

 - c. 倘獲父母或監護人資助者：
 - i. 足以顯示親屬關係之出生證明影本
 - ii. 父母或監護人之全本身份證件(護照尤佳)
 - iii. 父母或監護人之銀行存款餘額證明
6. 無犯罪證明

簽證及入境程序

取得簽證依不同國籍，需經 2 至 3 道程序：

1. 停留/觀光簽證
 - 於入境貝里斯時取得。
 - 效期30天。
 - 獎學金生初次入境。
2. 貝里斯簽證
 - 非墨西哥籍之受獎生須申請效期與其學程相當之簽證。
 - 一旦受獎生確復接受獎學金，即透過學務處學生事務組提出申請。

簽證選項

- 單次入境居留簽證：在學期間有效，不得跨國境旅行。費用200貝幣。
- 多次入境居留簽證：在學期間有效，得跨國境旅行。費用300貝幣
 - 每次再入境移民局將另收40貝幣。

國籍相關注意事項：

- 委內瑞拉籍：登機前須取得簽證否則將遭航空公司拒載。
- 墨西哥籍(搭飛機旅行者)：搭機前須出示證件，從陸路入境者不適用。
- 哥倫比亞籍(陸路)：在邊關須提供其他文件以供查驗。

學生許可證

- 所有學生均需申請學生許可證
- 墨西哥籍學生於抵達貝里斯後即可辦理。
- 其他國籍學生於獲得居留簽證後申請及核發
- 費用200貝幣(一學期100貝幣)

注意事項：學生須自行負擔簽證及學生證費用，簽證及學生證費用不包含在獎學金之內。能否獲核發多次入境簽證以及獲核發簽證所需時間，係由貝里斯移民署決定，非貝里斯大學所能決定。

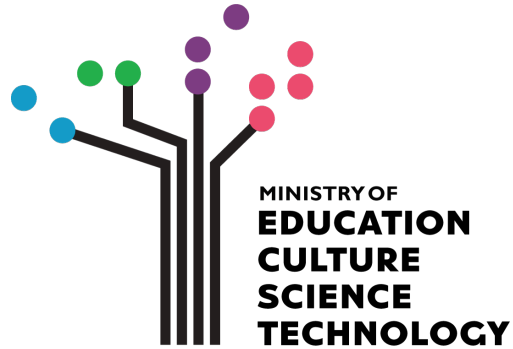

Government of Belize 2026–2027 Scholarship: Study English as a Second Language at the University of Belize

OVERVIEW

The University of Belize ESL Scholarship Program Overview

The University of Belize (UB), in partnership with the Government of Belize through the Ministry of Education, Culture, Science and Technology, invites applications for the 2026-2027 Certificate of English as a Second Language (CESL) Scholarship Programme. This ten-month intensive English language programme will be delivered at the Regional Language Center (RLC) from January to October 2027.

The scholarship covers all tuition, program fees, required teaching materials, and provides a monthly stipend of BZD \$600.00 to assist with living expenses.

PURPOSE

The ESL Program at the RLC

The CESL programme is designed to strengthen English proficiency in reading, writing, listening, and speaking. It emphasizes communicative competence, task-based learning, and practical application of language skills. A mandatory 60-hour language internship is required for eligible students.

INTENDED BENEFICIARIES

This scholarship is open to citizens of Mexico, Honduras, El Salvador, Colombia, Panama, Venezuela, and ROC Taiwan.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a citizen of México, Venezuela, Honduras, El Salvador, Colombia,

Panama, or ROC Taiwan.

- Applicants must be **18** or older.
- Must commit to 10 months of living in Belize from January 2027 to October 2027.
- Applicants must have a minimum high school certificate.
- Commit to studying full-time in Belize **without the possibility of employment or part-time studies.**

Restrictions:

- Only one applicant per immediate family or household will be considered. Applications from couples or spouses are not allowed.
- Spouses of Belizean citizens, as well as applicants holding Belizean passports, nationality, or permanent residency, are not eligible to apply.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must submit the following documents:

- Completed **UB/RLC application form.**
- Updated curriculum vitae (CV) with a profile photo. **If the CV is in a language other than English, it must be translated into English.**
- Official transcript (s) - must be apostilled and translated into English if in another language.
- Copy of certificates or diplomas - must be apostilled and translated into English if in another language.
- One recommendation form – either academic or from a current or previous employer. Should be using the [UB recommendation form template](#)
- Copy of your passport (*biographic page*) - must be apostilled and valid for more than 6 months
- Copy of your birth certificate - must be apostilled or authenticated and translated into English if in another language.
- Proof of financial support - updated bank statement (s)
- Application fee of BZD \$30 - payment can be made [using a credit card](#)

SCHOLARSHIP BENEFITS

The CESL Scholarship covers all tuition and program costs, including teaching materials, and provides a monthly housing allowance of BZD \$600 (US\$300).

Recipients are responsible for any additional living expenses beyond the allowance, which covers rent and utilities only. The University cannot increase the allowance or waive fees for extra costs.

The scholarship benefits apply only to the recipient and do not cover dependents.

The stipend is not sufficient to cover all expenses. Students must have additional financial support.

CULTURAL ENGAGEMENT & STUDENT LIFE

All Regional Language Center (RLC) students are required to participate in the annual Multicultural Fair, where scholarship recipients showcase the unique culture of their home countries. Students should bring items such as a national flag, traditional attire, photos, brochures, and cultural artifacts.

Students are also encouraged to bring:

- Personal medications and essential hygiene products
- Special condiments or ingredients for preparing traditional dishes
- Souvenirs or items for cultural displays

IMMIGRATION REQUIREMENTS (MANDATORY)

All selected scholarship recipients must comply with Belize's immigration regulations. Required Documents (to submit after scholarship acceptance)

1. Passport – biographical page and all pages
2. Apostilled passport
3. Apostilled academic records
4. Travel itinerary – arrival and departure dates
5. Financial statement of support, including supporting documents:
 - a. Most recent bank statement (monthly statement if self-funded)
 - b. Job letter (if employed)
 - c. If supported by parents or guardians:
 - i. Copy of your birth certificate to show kinship
 - ii. Copy of all pages of parents' or guardians' identification (passport preferred)
 - iii. Parent/guardian bank statement
6. Police record

Visa and Entry Process

The visa process may involve two or three steps, depending on nationality:

1. Visitor/Tourist Visa:
 - Issued upon entry to Belize at any border.
 - Valid for 30 days.
 - Allows initial entry for scholarship recipients.
2. Belize Visa:
 - Required for students (except Mexicans) to legally remain in Belize for the duration of studies.
 - Application is processed through the Department of Student Affairs, Student Services Unit, after scholarship acceptance.

Visa Options:

- Single-Entry Visa – valid for the duration of studies; does not allow travel across borders. Cost: BZD \$200.
- Multiple-Entry Visa – valid for the duration of studies and allows travel across borders. Cost: BZD \$300.
 - **Note:** An entry fee of BZD \$40 applies per re-entry.

Nationality-Specific Notes:

- Venezuelans: Must obtain a visa before boarding; airlines will not allow boarding without it.
- Mexicans (air travel): Must present documentation upon entry by air; does not apply for entry by land.
- Colombians (land entry): Additional documentation required at border points.

Student Permit

- All students must apply for a Student Permit.
- Mexican nationals: Permit applied for shortly after arrival.
- Other nationalities: Permit applied for after Belize Visa issuance.
- Cost: BZD \$200 total (BZD \$100 per semester).

Important: Students are responsible for all Visa and Student Permit costs. These are not included in the scholarship. The University of Belize cannot guarantee visa approval or processing times, which are determined solely by the Belize Immigration Department.

- Application Opens: April 20, 2026
- Application Deadline: July 31, 2026
- Expected date of arrival: January 11, 2027
- Programme Duration: January – October 2027

Application for Regional Language Center Admission

The University of Belize's Regional Language Centre (RLC) offers Certificates in English as a Second Language (CESL), customized courses for other languages, and language examinations in English and Spanish.

Admission Requirements:

- **Completed application** - Ensure all fields are filled out accurately.
(Incomplete applications will not be accepted)
- **Official Transcript** - Must be apostilled, translated and sourced from your most recent academic qualification
- **Copy of Diploma** - Must be apostilled and sourced from your most recent academic qualification
- **Copy of Birth Certificate** - Must be apostilled and submitted in English
- **Copy of Passport** (page with vital information)- Must be apostilled
- **Recommendation Letter** - One letter from an academic referee or employer (previous or current)
- **Curriculum Vitae** - Must be in English and must include a profile photo.
- **English Background** - Have a basic to Intermediate competence in English
- **Overall CGPA** - Must have a **2.5 CGPA or equivalent** from most recent academic qualification
- **Proof of Financial Support**- Updated bank statement
- **Commitment** - Must be able to fully commit to the 10-month program in Belize.
- **UB placement exam** - All applicants are required to take the English placement exam (This is administered by the University of Belize on the first week of classes)

Note: Any document not in English must be translated to English and apostilled in order to be considered.
Illegible submissions will not be accepted.

Submission of Application:

Once you have completed the checklist above, you are ready to submit your application package.

1. Gather all required documents listed in the application checklist.
2. Ensure all documents are properly scanned and saved in PDF format.
3. Sign in to your Google account or create one if you don't have it already. Then go to Google Drive and create a new folder.
4. Name the folder following the specified format - FirstLastName_RLCApplicant2026
5. Upload all the documents into this folder you just created and renamed.
6. Ensure all documents are clearly labeled with appropriate names.
7. Right-click on the folder in Google drive and select "Get shareable link". Copy the shareable link provided. *(Ensure it is public and anyone with the link can "view")*
8. Now, click on "gmail" button and compose a new email.
9. Address the email to admissions@ub.edu.bz and rlcinfo@ub.edu.bz
10. Use the subject line "RLC Application Package Submission - Your Full Name"
11. In the body of the email, introduce yourself briefly and state that you are submitting your application package.
12. Paste the copied link into the body of the email below your introduction.
13. Clearly indicate that the attached documents are also accessible via the shared Google Drive Folder.
14. Review the email to ensure all necessary information is included and attachments are correct.
15. Await confirmation receipt, if you do not receive confirmation within 15 days, consider following up to ensure your application was received.
